



# Mixed Paper & Cardboard Recycling



## Mixed Paper

A variety of mixed paper items are accepted for recycling at VPPSA sites. Here are some of the more common items that can be placed into the mixed paper container:

- NEWSPAPERS
- MAGAZINES
- CATALOGS
- TELEPHONE BOOKS
- JUNK MAIL
- OFFICE PAPER
- SCHOOL PAPER
- PAPER BAGS
- PAPERBOARD BOXES SUCH AS:
  - CEREAL BOXES
  - TISSUE BOXES
  - SHOE BOXES
  - PASTA BOXES
  - CRACKER BOXES



## Corrugated Cardboard

A separate container is designated for the collection of corrugated cardboard only. Flattened corrugated cardboard boxes, clean and dry, may be placed in the cardboard collection container for recycling.

### Here's a quick tip!

To determine if the item should go into the corrugated cardboard collection container, look for the layers.

If it has three layers, with the middle layer being 'wavy', then it is corrugated cardboard!
